Recipients of this communication are currently enrolled with us as full-time Juniors. This is a follow up communication to the one sent out via the US postal service and e-mail on February 28, 2022. To be in compliance with the NJ Department of Education, we will be scheduling the NJGPA which is a **graduation requirement for all Juniors to sit and take the exam**. During the week of March 14-18, and March 21-25 for make-ups, the exam will be proctored.

All students will report to their first period class for attendance. They will be dismissed after the announcements to their testing locations, either to the Gym or to B101 (location for students with approved accommodations). If your child is unsure where they will be testing, please have them reach out to their school counselor/case manager. Please see the attached schedules for when your child will be testing. In the event a student misses their lunch period due to testing, they will eat during the lunch period at the conclusion of the test.
