School begins at 7:45 am for all A session shared time and full time students. Students arriving before that time will be permitted to enter the building and wait in designated locations in the student cafeteria and gymnasium. For all C session shared time students, school begins at 12:09pm. Students arriving before that time will be reporting to the gymnasium.

Transportation

- Transportation is provided by sending school districts. Information on bus pickup is available through your local sending district coordinator. Nutritional Service

Proper nutrition is the foundation for a healthy lifestyle. Your student's greatest potential is enhanced with proper nutrition. To help children achieve their nutritional needs, food services are provided at SCVTHS.

- C session & Lunch: If your child does not have a lunch period provided by your sending school, contact his/her guidance counselor here at SCVTHS and the counselor will assist in making arrangements for your child to purchase and eat lunch upon arrival at our campus; a permanent lunch pass will be issued to your child.
- **Share-time C session students who receive free & reduced lunch at their sending district:** Sending districts are responsible for providing a "grab & go" lunch for students who cannot eat at their sending district. If your child does not have a lunch or lunch period provided by your sending school, contact his/her guidance counselor here at SCVTHS and the counselor will assist in making arrangements for your child eat lunch upon arrival at our campus; a permanent lunch pass will be issued to your child. All items must be purchased as Free & Reduced Lunch status is not transferrable between districts.

Student ID's

- Each student will be provided with a photo ID card and lanyard. Students are required to display their ID at all times. The first ID and lanyard are free. Replacement ID's with a lanyard is \$5.00. ID's are used for student access into buildings, lunch purchases, school functions, etc.

Student Drivers

- A parking pass is required to park on campus. Student parking passes are available for eligible students in the HS Main Office throughout the school year. The cost to park on campus is \$40.00/year. To obtain a parking pass, fill out the registration form and return with the parking fee. A parking pass will be issued once the application has been approved. All students must park in their assigned parking spot.
