<u>Inclement Weather/Non-Scheduled Closing Procedures:</u> When schools close due to weather related causes, road conditions and school personnel have to be considered in order to transport students safely. The procedures below regarding *Inclement Weather/Non-Scheduled Closing* are in place with students' safety being everyone's #1 priority.

District Where Student Resides: Delayed Opening

If your district has a delayed opening, busing for your child will run on your town's delay schedule, even if SCVTHS is on a regular schedule.

District Where Student Resides: Closings

If your district is closed, the bus does not pick up any students in that district, even if SCVTHS is open. Parents are responsible for providing transportation to and from SCVTHS.

SCVTHS: Delayed Opening

If SCVTHS has a delayed opening, "A" Session students will not be bused to Vo-Tech, even if your district is on a regular schedule.

SCVTHS: Early Dismissal

If SCVTHS has an early dismissal, transportation will be provided to students for return to home district. "C" Session students will not be bused to Vo-Tech, even if your district is on a regular schedule.

SCVTHS: Closing

If SCVTHS closes, no students will be bused to Vo-Tech, even if your district is on a regular schedule.

Scheduled School Breaks/Closing Procedures (planned calendar events): Not every district operates on the same calendar for school closings. Below pertains to transportation regarding scheduled school closings i.e. Spring Break, Winter Break, ½ days, etc., and the procedures in place to follow.

District Where Student Resides: Closed

If your district is closed, but SCVTHS is open, transportation will be provided to and from school by your home district.

- For delayed opening, "A" Session students will not be bused to Vo-Tech.
- For early dismissal, "C" Session students will not be bused to Vo-Tech.

SCVTHS: Closed

If SCVTHS is closed, no students will be bused to Vo-Tech, even if your district is on a regular schedule.
