#### C. 2009-2010 Annual School District Budget

On motion by Mr. Hyncik, seconded by Mrs. Ventantonio and passed on roll call vote, the Board of Education adopted the 2009-2010 annual school district budget for the General Fund in the amount of \$16,538,590 and the Special Revenue Fund of \$1,000,000 for a total of \$17,538,590. The proposed budget includes sufficient funds to provide curriculum and instruction which will enable all students to achieve the Core Curriculum Content Standards, and is in compliance with N.J.S.A. 18A and N.J.A.C. Title 6 and 6A. As per NJAC 6A:23B-1.2 (b), the proposed budget provides for a maximum expenditure amount that may be allotted for travel and expense reimbursement. The 2009-2010 budget includes a maximum travel appropriation of \$83,220. The School Business Administrator shall track and record these costs to insure that the maximum amount is not exceeded. Included in the 2009-2010 proposed budget is a maximum regular business travel amount of \$1,500 per employee.
