omerset County Vocational & Technical High School students recently competed against other career and technical education students from around the state at the 2013 New Jersey SkillsUSA Championships. Out of the 82 students from SCVTHS who competed, 46 received medals including 30 Gold. Those Gold medal winners are now eligible to test their skills at a national level in Kansas City on June 24-28 at the 2013 National Leadership and Skills Conference (NLSC). This will be the 49th annual National Leadership and Skills Conference (NLSC), where nearly 6,000 career and technical education students will showcase their talents and compete in 98 different trade, technical and leadership fields. All

contests are run with the help of industry, trade associations, and labor organizations. The test competencies are set by industry.
