- Provide a copy of the consequences from the student handbook
- 1 after school detention
- Copy provided to School Counselor and Supervisors

Offense 3

- Call home
- Contract meeting with Academy Counselor and Supervisors
- 2 days of after school detention
- Genesis input
- Grade of 0
- Provide a copy of the consequences from the student handbook

Grades

AHMS high-school classes will provide grades in a numerical and alphabetical format.

RVCC classes will provide grades in an alphabetical format on an RVCC transcript.

AHMS has a Criteria for Continued Enrollment which includes Accuplacer testing (further information will be mailed home) and GPA.

Valedictorian and Salutatorian Determination:

Using numerical averages there will be one recognized Valedictorian and one recognized Salutatorian for the SCVTS and AHMS programs.

Attendance and Vacations

SCVTHS classes follow the SCVTHS student handbook and RVCC professors follow the RV handbook.

Please consider the following for when students are predominantly on the RVCC schedule; specifically, during junior and senior years:

Please keep in mind when planning vacations to look at the SCVTHS schedule as well as the RVCC schedule. If a student needs to miss a class they are responsible for contacting the professors and making up the work. It is up to the professor's discretion what is allowed to be made up. Always seek guidance from the professors at the time.

Additional RVCC Classes

Students who have a GPA of 3.0 or higher in their RVCC courses at the **end of sophomore** year are eligible to take additional college courses.

Please note: We strongly advise students to consider that there is a difference between cumulative GPA (including HS courses) and just the RVCC GPA, and that an additional college course could have an adverse effect on their GPA. We urge interested students to meet with their School Counselor for more information.

There is an identified Criteria for Continued Enrollment in the Academy which includes the Accuplacer Test and GPA.

As a reminder, any Junior or Senior student with an RVCC GPA below a 3.0 must undergo an identified appeals process.
