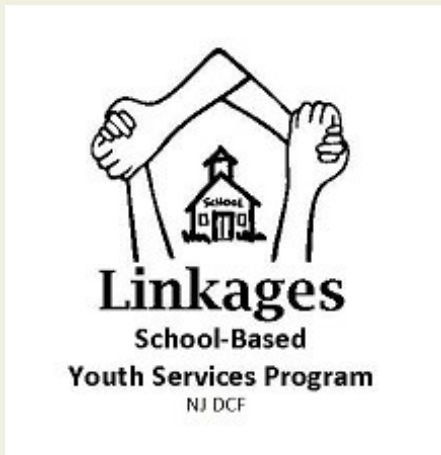


Linkages

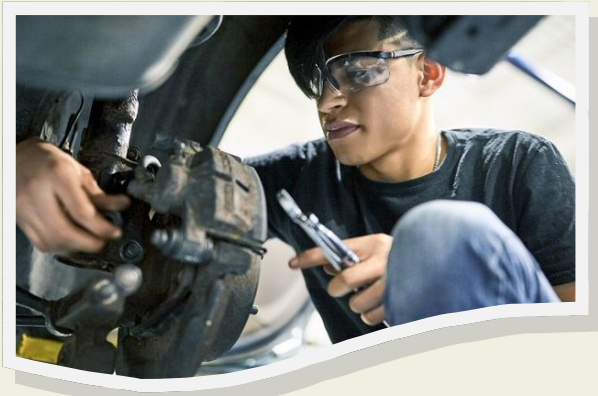

The Summer Twilight Program at Somerset County Vocational & Technical High School offers career and technical training, as well as academic skills training, for youth throughout Somerset County who are between 14-18 years of age.

The program serves capable youth in need of additional support services due to certain life circumstances that may include: attendance concerns, low income, discipline problems and family difficulties, etc.

In existence for over 31 years, the mission of the program is to prepare youth for the future by providing them with the skills, attitudes and support needed to participate effectively in the labor market and/or to continue their education. The program meets for 14 days in July (Monday-Thursday).

In addition to career and technical training, students receive academic instruction in both **math and language arts**. Forty minutes of academic instruction will be provided daily.

Summer Twilight Students are paid a stipend of \$7.00 per hour for a four-hour day, four days per week. Students must complete the entire program in order to be eligible for the stipend.
